(.1-.14) A coffee service consists of a coffee pot and lid, a creamer, a sugar bowl and lid, four coffee cups, four coffee saucers, and a serving tray. All of the pieces have a gold rim and feature navy blue silhouettes of men from the shoulders up which are enclosed in white circles set against dark brown textured backgrounds.
