



## Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal

### Description

A gold-plated medal depicts two six-pointed stars, one overlaid on the other. The overlaid star has white points with a golden outline. The star underneath it has diagonal raised lines on its points. In the center of the overlaid star, a green circle displays a golden silhouette of Vietnam and a red flame. The medal is suspended from a round metal loop with rounded corners that hangs from a vertically-

striped green and white ribbon. A silver banner pin, which displays raised numbers, is attached to the top of the ribbon.
